WOMEN & GOLF AT CLECKHEATON GC

Entry to competitions is open to everyone dependent on your membership category rather than your gender. However, some historic trophies which have been played for many years are for certain categories such as ladies, juniors, rabbits, men. Usually when there is a trophy competition, and you are not eligible to win the trophy, you will still be able to play for a divisional monetary prize.

. The following competitions are mostly played over 2 days – Tuesdays and the preceding Sunday. The tee is reserved for competitions on a Tuesday between 9.30 and 11am however you can play outside these times. On a Sunday you can play anytime if you are a 7 day member, and after 10am if you are a 5 day + member. If you are a 5 day member you are restricted to playing on a Tuesday.

The Tuesday/Sunday competition scores are amalgamated when the competition is closed. These are open to all men and women. However, men are unable to win the trophy. For example when it is the medal final day the best net women's score over the 2 days will win the trophy. A man or women can win the divisional monetary prizes. Entry to competitions is in the pro shop and entry fee is usually £3 which is deducted from your account. This can be 'topped up' using your membership card in the pro shop or over the bar, or on the ClubV1 app on your smart phone.

In addition to all the competitions listed below there will also be a 9 hole stableford on a Tuesday. Whilst we encourage you to play in our 18 hole competitions there are times when this is not possible. Entry to these are £2 and you will need to sign in in the Pro shop. The 9 hole competitions will count as a qualifying score for your handicap when course conditions allow, and the winner of each 9 hole stableford will qualify to play in the 9 Hole Stableford Final in July.

LADY CAPTAIN'S NEW YEAR COMP

This is held in January, usually at the start of the month, depending on the weather!

Traditionally a stableford held over 9 holes with a 2 course meal to follow.

NEW SEASON COMP

Usually held on the last Tuesday in March.

9 holes stableford with a 2 course meal to follow

MONTHLY MEDAL

Usually played on the first Tuesday and previous Sunday of the month. The female winner of each division will qualify for the Medal final which is played in conjunction with the monthly medal in July.

MONTHLY STABLEFORD

Usually played on the third Tuesday and previous Sunday of the month. The female winner of each division will qualify for the Stableford Final which is played in conjunction with the monthly stableford in July.

CIGARETTE BOX

18 hole individual medal competition. Played over 2 days – Tuesday and Sunday.

RITA BIRKETT CENTARY TROPHY

18 hole individual stableford competition. Played over 2 days – Tuesday and Sunday.

MR CAPTAIN'S DAY

18 hole individual medal. Played Tuesday and Sunday.

There will be a presentation at aprox 3.30pm on the Tuesday. If you play on the Sunday and are not able to attend the presentation you can nominate someone to collect your prize.

Juniors and male members are not eligible as The Captain provides separate prizes for those categories.

MACMILLAN CANCER SUPPORT

18 hole individual stableford
Played Tuesday and Sunday.
Donations for cancer support will be collected – this is separate to your competition entry fee.

LADIES INVITATION DAY

Ladies to invite and pay for a friend from another club.
Played as a 4BBB on a Tuesday in June.

LADY CAPTAINS DAY

Individual Medal 18 holes played on Tuesday and Sunday. If you played in competition time on Tuesday there will be a Halfway House with refreshments provided by the Ladies' Captain.

Prize for best gross & best net - Honors board is net Other prizes at Lady Captain's discretion.

Not open to juniors but Lady Captain may provide junior prize.

On the Tuesday evening there will be a prize presentation followed by a meal/entertainment.

MEDAL FINAL

To qualify you must win your division in a monthly medal competition from the previous July.

Divisional winners of Mr Captain's Day, Lady Captain's Day, the Cigarette Box and the Mike Ingham Vase will also qualify to play in the Medal Final.

Played in conjunction with a July medal.

This is an honours board competition.

MIKE INGHAM VASE

Mike was our Club professional for many years who still plays at the club.

He donated the vase in 2005 after he retired.

Individual 18 hole medal played Tuesday and Sunday.

This is an honours board competition.

STABLEFORD FINAL

To qualify you must win your division in a monthly stableford competition from the previous July.

Played in conjunction with a July stableford.

This is an honours board competion.

PAST CAPTAIN'S PLATE

Individual 9 hole stableford.
Followed by a presentation & lunch.
All Past female Presidents and Captains of Cleckheaton may enter but must still have active handicap.

MR PRESIDENTS DAY

18 hole individual stableford.

From 2024 there is now a trophy for the winner.

There will be a presentation at aprox 3.30pm on the Tuesday. If you play on the Sunday and are not able to attend the presentation you can nominate someone to collect your prize.

Juniors and male members are not eligible as The President provides separate prizes for those categories.

GOLF FOUNDATION STABLEFORD

18 hole individual stableford played Tuesday and Sunday. Winning score receives Golf Foundation Ball Marker

GRIMSHAW TROPHY

Played any time on a Thursday Individual 18 medal Open to ladies 50 years old and over.

CENTENARY CUP

Played in conjunction with a Monthly Medal. Open to ladies with handicap index up to 18.0

GRANNY COMPETITION

9 hole individual stableford played on a Thursday.

There is an informal presentation after the competition where last years winner will provide a prize.

Open to all ladies with grandchildren including step grandchildren.

LADY VICE CAPTAIN'S DAY

18 holes individual stableford played Sunday and Tuesday.

There will be a presentation at aprox 3.30pm on the Tuesday. If you play on the Sunday and are not able to attend the presentation you can nominate someone to collect your prize.

STELLA'S TWOs

Stella was a previous lady member who started the competition, and always invited the players back to her house for tea and fruit cake before presenting the winner with a handbag. When she had to go into the care home we had the presentation at Hartshead Care Home where she spent her last years.

Sadly, Stella is no longer with us.

But we still play for a handbag, in honor of Stella, and now the prize is bought with the money collected in entry fees.

It is an 18 hole Medal played on Tuesday and Sunday.

All ladies who have a gross 2 in a competition on a Sunday or Tuesday will qualify to play in Stella's Twos Final.

A notice goes up in locker room after the current year's final. Sign up and pay £2.50 entry fee. You must have entered the competition before you have a 2! Those who join the club or obtain a handicap after the notice has been taken down can still enter – let the competition secretary know.

ECLECTIC COMPETITION

A notice goes up in locker room 1st Jan for 4 weeks £2.50 entry fee, must have paid at the start of the season unless joined or obtained your handicap after the start date. At ladies Annual Meeting in October prizes are given for the best eclectic scores in 3 divisions.

END OF SEASON COMPETITION

9 hole individual medal, all ladies to provide a prize around £5 Presentation where all ladies receive a prize in winning order from those provided by all players.

A 2 course meal to follow play/presentation.

CHRISTMAS COMPETITION

Stableford played over 18 or 16 holes weather dependent! Winner receives 6 bottles of wine presented at Christmas dinner.

TINSEL & TURKEY

9 hole stableford fun competition, ladies dress up in Christmas outfits. Played on aTuesday.

Lunch follows play (usually turkey sandwiches)

WEBSTER TROPHY

Individual match play, starts early in the season £3 entry
Full handicap allowance based on COURSE HANDICAP open to all ladies
and junior girls.

Email from pro shop announcing competition is open Enter on club website, you will be informed of draw and dates for rounds.

MIXED KNOCKOUT

Mixed pairs foursomes match play, starts early in the season £4 pp entry. Handicap allowance is ½ the difference of the aggregate handicaps based on COURSE HANDICAP open to all 7, 5, & 5+ members.
